<b>Emergency Care</b>			
<b>CPR Training</b>	3hrs	R 377.50	<b>CPR Training</b> - This program teaches basic life support and addresses breathing and cardiac emergencies in caring for adults, children, and infants. It is also designed to facilitate the efficient training, testing, and retesting in correct methods of cardio pulmonary resuscitation for the layman.
